Homeownership Program Application Guide

The Siksika Housing Homeownership Program allows for the transfer of unoccupied Siksika Homes to Siksika citizens for the purpose of private homeownership accommodation.

As a private homeowner on Siksika lands you accept responsibility for maintaining the condition and insurance on your home and therefore you are not required to make a monthly maintenance fee or rent payments to Siksika Housing Department.

To be eligible for the Siksika Housing Program interested applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Not have any outstanding accounts owing to Siksika Housing.
2. Must be using the house for accommodations and not as a private rental.
3. Must be willing to give up occupancy if currently residing in a Siksika House that is designated as part of the rental program.
4. Must provide confirmation of financing that is equal or greater than amount of the repairs that have been identified by Siksika Housing.
5. Siksika Housing will consider the transfer of a Siksika House that you are currently residing in provided it meets the criteria for this program.

Please note that approved applicants must complete all identified repairs within 6 months of approval, pay a \$1 transaction fee to Siksika Housing Department and execute the Siksika Nation Custom Allotment Agreement for Residential Purposes.

If you are interested in applying, please complete the Siksika Housing Homeownership Application Form and submit it to Siksika Housing Department in person or via email.

Houses will be transferred on a first come, first serve basis.
